Data Handling Agreement - Specified purpose

The FPHS holds personal data on current and past members for the purposes of administering the Society and to enable the provision of membership services. - to keep your information up-to-date (you have a responsibility to keep us informed of any relevant changes).

We do not and will not share this data with any other organisation other than with our Journal printer to send out paper copies of the Journal package and this is dealt with under a data sharing agreement.
